What You Need/Should Bring to an eReader Appointment

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Your fully-charged device(s)</p>	<p>Bring the device(s) you want to use to access our digital collection: Kindle, Nook, iPod, tablet, smart phone, laptop, etc.</p> <p>If your device isn't WiFi-accessible, please bring the laptop you will use to download books to your tablet. NOTE: we cannot download items onto your device from our computers.</p> <p>Find a full list of devices compatible with OverDrive @ help.overdrive.com/#devices.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Library Card</p>	<p>Can't find your card? We can look up the number.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Library PIN</p>	<p>The default pin is the last four digits of your library card. You may have written down a different number when you got your card. We can always reset your PIN number.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>E-mail</p>	<p>Access to your email and password</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>App Store Log on</p>	<p>Please have the username/email and password associated with whichever application store you have on your device: App Store for Apple devices, PlayStore for Nooks, Amazon for Kindles, etc.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Amazon Account</p>	<p>Please have the username/email and password that is associated with your account.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Adobe ID</p>	<p>To create a free Adobe ID, go to accounts.adobe.com/</p> <p>If it says your email already has an Adobe ID, you can also reset your password here.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Questions</p>	<p>There are no bad questions, so don't be afraid to ask them. If we don't know the answer right away we can look it up, and if all else fails we will refer you to someone who can.</p>

Bee Cave Public Library eResources



OverDrive is a one stop shop for eBooks and eAudiobooks. You can have up to 5 items out at a time for 2 weeks (with the option to renew). You can also have up to 3 items on hold. Don't forget to look for the "starred a" symbol for Advantage titles (titles with extra and exclusive copies for Bee Cave Library card holders). Try downloading these before your appointment to speed things along.

Applications For OverDrive

<p>OverDrive</p> 	<p>While you can access OverDrive from your web browser, you can streamline your eReader experience by downloading the app. If you belong to multiple libraries with OverDrive, you can download and read all your books and listen to audiobooks in the same application. When you search for "OverDrive" in the app store, look for the "OverDrive-Library eBooks and..." application. OverDrive Media console also pops up, but it is actually the exact same thing. This app is used for both the eBook and eAudio collections through OverDrive. You can check out 5 items at a time for two weeks with the option of renewal.</p>
<p>Kindle App</p> 	<p>For non-Kindle devices, use the Kindle app to read Kindle-format eBooks. Don't worry, it's just formatting, you do NOT need a physical Kindle. Please make sure your app is connected to your Amazon account.</p>
<p>Adobe Digital Editions</p> 	<p>Required to read eBooks in ePub format when not using the Overdrive app. Again, it's just formatting. This is why you need an Adobe ID.</p>

*These applications are recommendations and only certain devices need/have them. Do not worry if your device can't download them or you want to wait until your session to install them.

<p>Zinio</p> 	<p>Check out some digital magazines today! Download the issue to your device and it's yours to keep.</p>
<p>TumbleBooks</p> 	<p>Kids' books come alive with Tumble Books. Animated, talking picture books, chapter books, games and more in several languages.</p>
<p>Mango</p> 	<p>Learn a new language. It's as simple as creating a profile through our website.</p>
<p>TexShare</p> 	<p>Have a project to do, or just want to learn something new? Try TexShare for authoritative, verified sources on a wealth of topics.</p>
<p>Ancestry</p> 	<p>Find out who you are with the Ancestry app. Only available to use inside the library due to licensing restrictions.</p>
